MPA classes are taught more than one time per year, including summer semester. Joint Degree students should consult with the MPA coordinator when changing proposed semesters for MPA classes, and Judy Parker in the MSW office must be notified to help keep the Program of Study up to date. Note: Students may not share courses between degrees.

Students in the fall of their second year will receive information on all concentrations and graduate certificates to determine their choice(s) of focus during their third year program of study.

All students in the second concentration year of study must take one practice class outside their concentration as an elective.

Students must receive a grade of C+ or better in any classes needed for graduation or to go on to the next class in any sequential series of classes (e.g. SW 6001/6002 and SW 6140 /6240 and SW 6120/SW 6220) and must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA to be in good academic standing.
