Course Sequence Information

- SW 2100 is to be completed before or in first term of BSW program
- SW 3110 may not be taken with other Practice courses and is to be completed in first term of BSW program
- SW 4430 and SW 4440 should be taken in the same semester
- Students MUST complete all BSW core required classes, including their SW elective, before commencing their practicum semester(s). If a student is in the SUDTTC program, they will be permitted to take required SUDC classes during their BSW field practicum placement. In addition, students may choose to take classes outside of Social Work for a minor, second major, certificate, or general electives during their practicum semester(s) but should discuss this with their advisor first.
- SW 4702 and SW 4782 comprise a 400-hour practicum experience and are to be taken in final program term

Graduation Application Deadlines and Information:

- Students may apply for graduation once they have earned 90 credits (CIS-->Student Homepage-->Graduation). Be sure to have declared all majors and minors before submitting an application. Check graduation.utah.edu for important dates and deadlines.
- The Graduation Division evaluates each student record for any duplicate or repeated courses. Students may not receive additional credit for repeated courses (some exceptions apply). Any duplicate/repeated credits will be removed from the student's record, which could affect eligibility for graduation
 - o U of U repeated courses: the most recent attempt, not the highest grade, will be included in GPA and credit calculation.
