**Courses:**

- All courses are held on Thursday evenings.
- Practicum (fieldwork) is completed on other weekdays, for a total of 450 hours in the second year and 600 hours in the third year. *The majority of practicum placements are during normal business hours and evening/weekend opportunities are likely to be unavailable.*

**Grades:**

- All MSW students must earn a C+ or better in each of the required courses, including Practicum, in order to take the second course in any sequenced courses (e.g. Practice I and Practice II), and in order to move forward in the program
- All MSW students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA in order to be in good academic standing

**Area of Focus:**

- Students in the Child Welfare (Title IV-E) MSW Program will take courses in the Child Welfare area of focus
- All MSW students must complete a Practice course outside their area of focus

**Reminders:**

- Students in the Child Welfare (Title IV-E) MSW Program must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours to graduate
- Only courses offered within the Child Welfare (Title IV-E) MSW Program may be taken (section numbers 730, 731)
- Registration is by permission code. Your advisor will send registration information and permission codes ahead of each semester. Your seat in each course is reserved.
