## **Courses:**

- All first-year courses are held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- All second-year courses are held on Thursdays and Fridays.
- Practicum (fieldwork) is completed on other weekdays. The majority of practicum placements are during normal business hours.

#### **Grades:**

- MSW students must earn a C+ or better in each of the required courses, including Practicum, to take the second course in any sequenced courses (e.g., Practice I and Practice II) and to move into the second year of the program.
- MSW students must maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA in order to be in good academic standing.

# Additional Coursework:

- Students must take one Advanced Practice course outside of chosen area of focus in year two.
- School Social Work is not an area of focus. School SW courses count as electives, and only students admitted to the School Social Work career path may take these courses.

## Reminders:

- Students may take up to 16 credit hours in any one semester without requiring pre-approval from the MSW Program Director and the Dean of the Graduate School (see request form in the Canvas modules).
- Students in the Two-Year Program must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours in order to graduate.
