Mountain High is alternative school of choice for 11th and 12th grade students who generally are behind in credit for graduation. Capacity is 300 students. Students are referred through their home high school.

Mountain High Practicum Highlights

- Clinically supervised individual treatment
- Create curriculum & facilitate groups
- Classroom skill instruction
- 2 hours a week of direct supervision
- Learn to diagnose, create treatment plans, and compose clinical notes.

Practicum Hours

- Hours must be obtained during regular school hours M-Th 8am-2:30pm. Fridays 8am-12:30pm.

Stipend

- Sorry, no stipend is being offered.
- BUT...if you ever want to work as a social worker in a school district you will need a school-based practicum for school licensure.
