Vision

Population: We serve the male offender population who qualify for a substance use disorder as diagnosed in the DSM V housed at the Draper site of the Utah State Prison.

Students will be trained in Cognitive Behavioral Interventions for Substance Abuse (CBI-SA) a treatment curriculum created by the University of Cincinnati. “As the name of the curriculum suggests, this intervention relies on a cognitive

behavioral approach to teach participants strategies for avoiding substance abuse. The program places heavy emphasis on skill building activities to assist with cognitive, social, emotional, and coping skill development.”

Types of Social Work opportunities:

Micro: Biweekly Individual therapy sessions

Macro: Opportunities to coordinate services within entire department of corrections

Mezzo: Weekly group therapy sessions following the CBI-SA curriculum May facilitate a group focusing on overcoming trauma as well

Stipend: \$11.15 an hour

Supervision: 2 forms of supervision are offered individual weekly supervision for 1 hour with a licensed LCSW and then weekly group supervision with all interns at the prison with various supervisors to learn more about working with addictions and a criminal population.

Work Times: Monday and Friday 7am – 4pm (you don’t have to work all of these hours, but all hours worked need to be in this time frame)

Travel requirements: None

Prerequisites: Be able to pass a criminal background check
